28,850 children and youth accessed programs to reach their highest potential



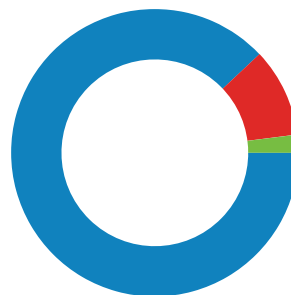
31,078 individuals and families were helped by programs and initiatives supporting personal wellbeing and safety
